RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A 20-FOOT AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA) ACCESSIBLE PARKING ZONE AT 3040 FAIR OAKS AVENUE IN THE NORTH FAIR OAKS AREA OF UNINCORPORATED REDWOOD CITY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507, et seq., and Section 7.44.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allow this Board of Supervisors to establish Americans with Disabled Act (ADA) disabled parking zone locations by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a disabled (ADA) parking zone be established at 3040 Fair Oaks Avenue in the North Fair Oaks area of unincorporated Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

A Disabled (ADA) Parking Zone is established at the address of 3040 Fair Oaks
 Avenue, Redwood City, on the southerly side of Fair Oaks Avenue (County Road
 1416B) commencing at approximately 116 feet south-east of the center line of

Second Avenue and extending south-easterly on Fair Oaks Avenue a distance of 20 feet, more or less.

2. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to post any necessary signs and pavement markings.
