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RESOLUTION:

- A) ADOPTING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE SANTA CRUZ AVENUE/ALAMEDA DE LAS PULGAS COMPLETE STREET PROJECT – WEST MENLO PARK AREA; AND**
- B) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO CALL FOR SEALED PROPOSALS TO BE RECEIVED BY THURSDAY, MAY 16, 2024 AT 2:30 P.M. IN THE OFFICE OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OFFICER/CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS; AND**
- C) AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO EXTEND THE CALL FOR BIDS AND BID OPENING UP TO SIXTY (60) CALENDAR DAYS BEYOND THE TIME AND DATE ORIGINALLY SET FORTH BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, on October 20, 2020 this Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 077821, which approved the Santa Cruz Avenue/Alameda de las Pulgas Complete Street Project (Project) alternative and supported an application to the San Mateo Transportation Authority for pedestrian and bicycle program funding for design and permitting of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2023 this Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution No. 079531, which authorized the Director of Public Works, or designee, to file an application for funding assigned to Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) committing any necessary matching funds, and stating assurance to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, the MTC administers state and federal funds to support programs that make walking and biking better travel options through their 2023 Regional Active Transportation Program Cycle 6 (ATP Cycle 6); and

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2024 the Department of Public Works submitted a request for the programmed allocation of ATP Cycle 6 funds; and

WHEREAS, on March 22, 2024 the California Transportation Commission approved the allocation of ATP Cycle 6 funds in the amount of \$5,435,000; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications dated April 19, 2024 have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works for the Project, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the “plans and specifications”); and

WHEREAS, the plans and specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. The plans and specifications dated Friday, April 19, 2024 for the aforesaid Project, which are on file in the office of the Director of Public Works, and to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and

adopted as the plans and specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for the improvements described therein.

2. Said specifications require that the contractors performing the work pay not less than the general prevailing wages, as established by the Department of Industrial Relations, in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each type of worker needed to execute the contract.
3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed bids and to set the bid opening date and time on Thursday, May 16, 2024 at 2:30 p.m. in the office of the County Executive Officer/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in the Hall of Justice, Redwood City, California. Said bids will be received by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors and then transmitted to the County Executive's Office in said Hall of Justice and be publicly opened and declared.
4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bids and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed bids to be published for three (3) times in a weekly local newspaper of general circulation, published in the County, and obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Department of Public Works.

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
