BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION ADOPTING PLANS, DATED JANUARY 20, 2009, AND SPECIFICATIONS, DATED JANUARY 22, 2009, INCLUDING CONFORMANCE WITH PREVAILING WAGE SCALE REQUIREMENTS AND CALLING FOR SEALED PROPOSALS ON TUESDAY, MAY 12, 2009, AT 2:30 P.M., FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PHASE II OF THE COASTAL TRAIL AT MIRADA SURF IN EL GRANADA

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, plans dated January 20, 2009, and specifications dated January 22, 2009, have been prepared and approved by the Director of Public Works and Director of Parks for the construction of the Phase II segment of the California Coastal Trail at Mirada Surf in El Granada, and said plans and specifications have been filed in the office of the Director of Public Works (the "Plan and Specifications"); and

WHEREAS, a schedule of prevailing wage scales for each craft or type of workman needed to execute the contract in the locality in which said work is to be performed has been established by the Department of Industrial Relations and has been referred to in said Plans and Specifications.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED as follows:

1. The Plans and Specifications, to which reference is hereby made for further particulars, are hereby approved and are adopted as the Plans and Specifications to be adhered to in letting and performing the work under a contract for said

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improvements.

2. The schedule of prevailing wages referred to in said Plans and Specifications has been determined to contain the general prevailing rates of wages in the locality in which said work is to be performed for each craft or type of workman needed to execute said contract.
3. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to issue a call for sealed proposals to be received by the County Manager/Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center, Redwood City, California, San Mateo County, on or before 2:30 p.m., May 12, 2009, in said office in the Hall of Justice and Records, Redwood City, California. Said bids will then be transmitted to the Board of Supervisor's Chambers in said Hall of Justice and Records and be publicly opened and declared.
4. The Director of Public Works is authorized to extend the call for bid and bid opening up to sixty (60) calendar days beyond the time and date originally set forth by the Board of Supervisors.
5. The Department of Public Works is further directed to cause the Notice inviting sealed proposals to be published for three (3) times in the Independent Newspaper Group, a newspaper printed and published in this County, and to obtain an affidavit of said publication, a copy of which shall be placed on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.




