BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH STARVISTA TO PROVIDE
AFTERCARE SERVICES TO EMANCIPATED FOSTER AND PROBATION YOUTH
FOR THE TERM JULY 1, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$414,749**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Aftercare program administered by the Human Services Agency's (HSA) Children and Family Services (CFS) branch, serves former foster youth who turned 18 while in the care of the State/County, are no longer dependents of the juvenile court, and have not yet reached age 25; and

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2024, the Human Services Agency ("HSA") issued a Request for Proposals ("RFP") to identify a provider of Aftercare services for emancipated foster and probation youth, and selected StarVista based on the RFP evaluation criteria/scoring that included method and approach, and organizational experience; and

WHEREAS, HSA requests the County enter into an agreement with StarVista to provide Aftercare services to include ongoing case management, job readiness training, emergency food, clothing, and referrals to community-based organizations to empower

them to become healthy, self-sufficient members of the community by supporting strength-based resiliency; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby StarVista will provide Aftercare services for the term of July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2027 for a total obligation not to exceed \$414,749; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as to both form and content, and desires to enter same.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
