**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A DONATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FROM
THE SILICON VALLEY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT THE
GURANTEED INCOME PILOT PROGRAM**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the Guaranteed Income (GI) Pilot program, operated by the Human Services Agency's (HSA) Children and Family Services (CFS) branch, aims to bridge the gap for the Non-Minor Dependent population, as well as former foster youth as they exit the foster care system and experience a critical transition period; and

WHEREAS, the Silicon Valley Community Foundation (SVCF) is a donor-advised community foundation and non-profit organization serving the Silicon Valley Region, that works to dismantle systemic barriers and give all children and their families access to the care, education, and resources they need to flourish; and

WHEREAS, recently HSA received a donation from the SVCF in the amount of \$100,000 to support the GI Pilot Program; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to County Administrative Memo-B3, "[r]eceipt of each gift or bequest having a value of more than \$2,500 or with significant conditions or stipulations shall be acknowledged in writing by the [County] department head and

referred to the Board of Supervisors for acceptance or rejection[,]” and this Board desires to accept the above-described donation in the amount of \$100,000 to be used for the GI Pilot Program; and

WHEREAS, concurrent with this resolution, the Board will be approving an Appropriation Transfer Request in the amount of \$100,000, recognizing unanticipated revenue from the above-described donation and transferring such amount to HSA.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that pursuant to County Administrative Memorandum B-3, the Board accepts the donation in the amount of \$100,000 from Silicon Valley Community Foundation to support the Guaranteed Income Pilot program.
