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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH WEHOPE FOR HOMELESS OUTREACH SERVICES TO ADD \$685,512 IN FUNDS FOR A NEW TOTAL OBLIGATION AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,345,512 AND TO EXTEND THE TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2025

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in close collaboration with community partners and other San Mateo County organizations, the Human Services Agency (HSA) coordinates homeless outreach program services to engage and serve homeless individuals living outside through consistent outreach to provide services, build rapport, and connect individuals to shelters and permanent housing; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2022, by Resolution No. 079010, this Board entered into an agreement with WeHOPE for the term of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024 in the amount of \$480,000 to provide street-based outreach and other services with the goal of assisting southern San Mateo County residents who are unsheltered and experiencing homelessness; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2022, by Resolution No. 079385, this Board amended its agreement with WeHOPE to add \$180,000 in funds for two additional staff to provide outreach and engagement services in the Southern region of San Mateo County, for a revised total amount of \$660,000; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the agreement to add \$685,512 in funds to increase the capacity for street-based outreach and case management services to southern San Mateo County's unsheltered homeless population by two additional full-time outreach case managers for FY 2023-24 and extend the term of the contract through June 30, 2025;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
