RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FROM THE SILICON VALLEY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION TO SUPPORT THE BIG LIFT INITIATIVE

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, The Big Lift Initiative is a program launched in 2012 with the aim of improving children’s reading proficiency in San Mateo County by third grade through coordinated and aligned interventions; and

WHEREAS, The Big Lift Initiative focuses on expanding preschool access, providing summer programs emphasizing literacy and STEM opportunities, reducing chronic absenteeism, and fostering partnerships among schools, families, and local community organizations; and

WHEREAS, the Silicon Valley Community Foundation is providing a grant to support the Big Lift Initiative in the amount of \$100,000; and

WHEREAS, the grant from Silicon Valley Foundation will be instrumental in advancing the mission of The Big Lift by allocating funds for marketing, communication and other related program operational activities; and

WHEREAS, concurrent with this resolution, the Board will be approving an Appropriation Transfer Request in the amount of \$100,000, recognizing unanticipated revenue from the above-described grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that pursuant to County Administrative Memorandum B-3, the Board accepts the grant in the amount of \$100,000 from Silicon Valley Community Foundation to support The Big Lift Initiative.
