

**SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND  
FOCUS STRATEGIES**

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into this \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_, 20\_\_\_\_, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called "County," and Focus Strategies, hereinafter called "Contractor";

**W I T N E S S E T H:**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof; and

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an Agreement for the purpose of providing training and technical assistance to safety net providers and the Human Services Agency on July 13, 2021 in the amount of \$675,000; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2023 the parties amended the Agreement to add \$140,000 in funds for an increase in current services; and

WHEREAS, the parties now wish to amend the Agreement to add \$35,338 in funds in order to increase the amount of technical assistance projects that Contractor can provide, for a revised total obligation of \$850,338.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:**


**1. Section 3. Payments** of the Agreement is amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibit A, County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit B. County reserves the right to withhold payment if County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed **EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$850,338)**. In the event that the County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by the County at the time of contract termination or expiration. Contractor is not entitled to payment for work not performed as required by this Agreement.

- 2. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement dated July 13, 2021 and amended on May 23, 2023 between the County and Contractor shall remain in full force and effect.**
