## Assemblymember Phil Ting

*as retiring representative of California's 19th Assembly District*

**WHEREAS**, beginning his public service as the Executive Director of the Asian Law Caucus in 2002, **Phil Ting** was appointed as Assessor-Recorder of the City and County of San Francisco and was elected by voters later that year, where he served until 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, during his tenure as the Assessor-Recorder, **Phil Ting** closed a five-year assessment backlog and brought in \$290 million in unpaid property taxes to the city, created a program to increase rooftop solar installations, and spearheaded efforts to assist homeowners and tenants facing foreclosure; and

**WHEREAS**, **Phil Ting** was elected to California's 19<sup>th</sup> Assembly District in 2012, which spans the westside of San Francisco, as well as the communities of Broadmoor, Colma, Daly City, and parts of South San Francisco and San Bruno; and

**WHEREAS**, **Phil Ting** authored numerous bills that were signed into law with substantial improvements for California residents on topics such as firearms, electric vehicles, clean energy, civil rights, greenhouse gas emissions, transgender rights, vote-by-mail, accessory dwelling units, navigation centers, surplus lands, worker protections, waste reduction, and hazardous chemicals; and

**WHEREAS**, for over 12 years, **Phil Ting** has diligently represented the residents of the counties of San Mateo and San Francisco, and as Chair of the Assembly Budget Committee, was a leading voice on state finances and brought historic investments in housing, public safety, education, childcare, environmental protections, and anti-discrimination measures; and

**WHEREAS**, after being appointed to the Chair of the Assembly Budget Committee in 2016, **Phil Ting** was instrumental in securing \$129 million in Vehicle Licensing Fee shortfall funding for the 20 municipalities of San Mateo County and the County of San Mateo.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby honors and congratulates **Phil Ting** for his service, leadership, and tireless dedication to San Mateo County.
