**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN AMERICAN WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA)  
PARKING ZONE ON HALSEY AVENUE IN THE NORTH FAIR OAKS AREA**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et. al. and Section 7.44.010 of the San Mateo County Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish disabled (ADA) parking zone locations by resolution; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works has recommended that a disabled (ADA) parking zone be established at 2750 Halsey Avenue in the North Fair Oaks area of unincorporated Redwood City; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors adopt:

1. A Disabled (ADA) Parking Zone is established at the address of 2750 Halsey Avenue, Redwood City, on the southerly side of Halsey Avenue (County Road 649) commencing at approximately 27 feet south-east of the center line of

Warrington Avenue and extending south-easterly on Halsey Avenue a distance of 20 feet, more or less.

2. The Department of Public Works is authorized and directed to post any necessary signs and pavement markings.
