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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SAN MATEO TO CONTINUE PROVIDING FIREARM RELINQUISHMENT AND ENFORCEMENT SERVICES, INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF THE AGREEMENT BY \$600,000 FOR A NEW TOTAL OBLIGATION AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,300,000 AND EXTENDING THE TERM BY 2 YEARS FOR A REVISED TERM OF NOVEMBER 21, 2022, THROUGH NOVEMBER 20, 2026

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Gun Relinquishment Task Force (“GRTF”) is a unit, within the San Mateo County District Attorney’s Office, led by the District Attorney Chief Inspector or Senior Inspector (“DA Inspector”) comprised of law enforcement officers from the County and its cities and towns; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the GRTF is to coordinate and share resources among the law enforcement agencies in the County to more effectively enforce unlawful firearm possession laws, in the interest of promoting safety and reducing gun violence in the County; and

WHEREAS, the County has partnered with the City of San Mateo to assign one or more peace officer “Officer(s)”) to the GRTF to staff the GRTF and support its efforts related to enforcing state and local firearm laws, firearms relinquishment, detection of armed prohibited persons, and to improve coordination among the various local law enforcement agencies within the County; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to execute an amendment to the Agreement between the County and the City of San Mateo for firearm relinquishment and enforcement services to extend the term through November 20th 2026, and to increase the amount authorized to the expended under the agreement to \$1,300,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with form of such amendment and has examined and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter the amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors by adoption of this resolution hereby authorizes the District Attorney of the County of San Mateo or Designee to execute said agreement amendment for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney (DA) or DA's designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term of services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
