## AT&IT and the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Peninsula

## For the launch of the AT&T Connected Learning Center at the Menlo Park Clubhouse

WHEREAS, AT&T has launched its Connected Learning initiative as part of a \$5 billion commitment to bridge the digital divide and help 25 million people get and stay connected to affordable, high-speed internet access and digital resources by 2030;

WHEREAS, research shows that tens of millions of Americans still lack access to wired or fixed wireless broadband connections; and

WHEREAS, since 2021, AT&T has opened more than 60 Connected Learning Centers across the United States to provide underserved communities access to the internet, computers, digital literacy tools, and training to allow them to fully participate in the digital world; and

WHEREAS, each Connected Learning Center represents an investment of up to \$50,000 and a commitment to long-term support, empowering students and families to thrive by ensuring equitable access to opportunities for learning, career development, and essential services; and

WHEREAS, AT&T has partnered with the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Peninsula, with its long history of providing mentorship, academic support, and safe spaces for young people, to bring a Connected Learning Center to its Menlo Park Clubhouse; and

WHEREAS, this new Center will provide students with critical digital tools and virtual learning resources necessary to succeed in school, in the workforce, and in their personal lives; and

WHEREAS, the Connected Learning Center at the Menlo Park Clubhouse will join a growing network of Centers nationwide that have already served more than 87,000 individuals, helping young and old safely and successfully navigate the digital world; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby recognizes and commends **AT&T** and the **Boys & Girls Clubs of the Peninsula** for launching the Connected Learning Center at the Menlo Park Clubhouse, and for their ongoing commitment to bridging the digital divide and empowering the next generation.
