# Prospect Street Red Curb Petition

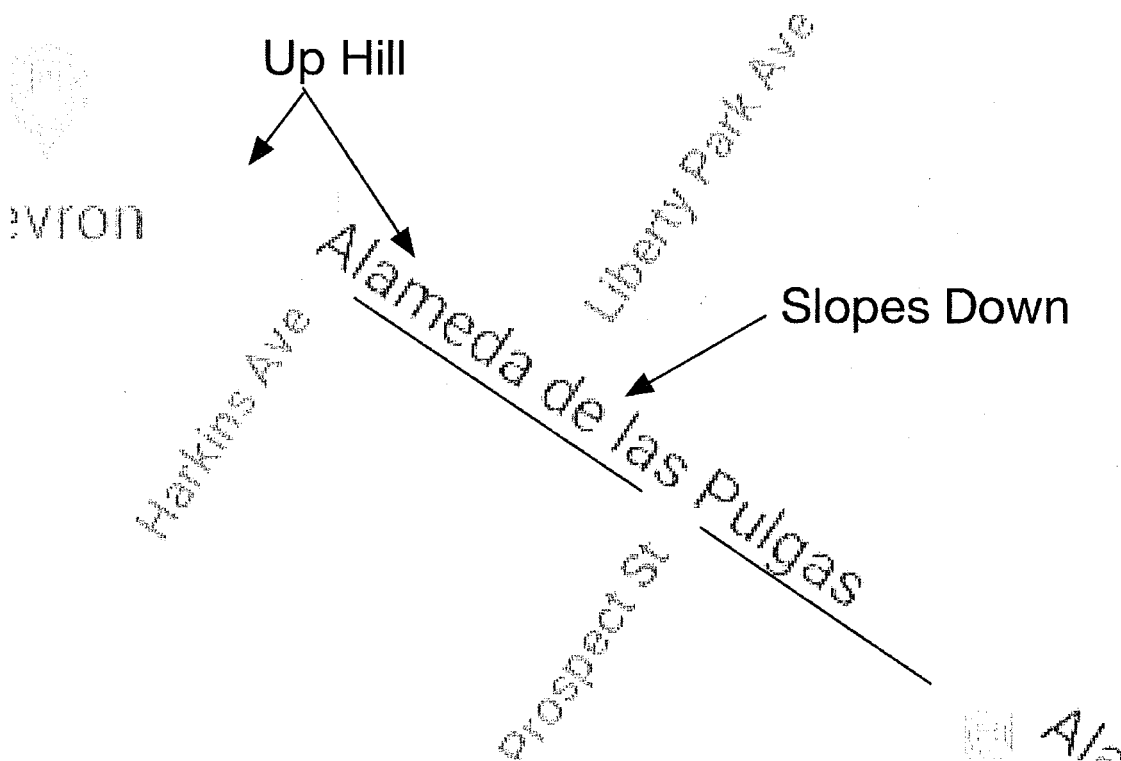
The following petition has been circulated amongst the residents of Prospect Street, Menlo Park for the purpose of requesting the County to paint the curbs surrounding the entrance to Prospect Street Red. (Red lines in map below).

Recently we have had a number of Uber and Lyft drivers parking their large vehicles along the Alameda, blocking visibility for anyone pulling out onto Alameda de las Pulgas from Prospect Street. This is very dangerous, especially given the road dips a bit and one is actually looking up at the vehicle obstructing the view.

The county recently added speed reduction signs on the Alameda because of the elderly residents in the area, which is much appreciated. Yet vehicle speed continues to be a problem on this stretch of the road, and given the obstructed view it is only a matter of time before an accident takes place. Note there are some businesses at the bottom of the hill (500 or so feet), but this stretch of the Alameda is not used for customer parking.
