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RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) PROCESS AND AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY TO EXECUTE A FIVE-YEAR AGREEMENT WITH AXON ENTERPRISE, INC TO CONTINUE USING THE APPLICATION PROGRAMMING INTERFACE (API) THAT ENABLES ACCESS BETWEEN AXON'S PLATFORM, EVIDENCE.COM, AND PROSECUTOR BY KARPEL, FOR THE TERM OF MAY 1, 2024 THROUGH APRIL 30, 2029 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$492,577.80

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance a five year agreement between the District Attorney's Office and Axon Enterprise, Inc for the continued access to the application programming interface (API) that enables access between Axon's platform, evidence.com, and Prosecutor by Karpel; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney's Office has contracted with Axon Enterprise, Inc in prior years, and the proposed five-year agreement will provide software interface between Axon and the District Attorney's case management system, Prosecutor by Karpel, commencing May 1, 2024 through April 30, 2029, for a total payment obligation not to exceed \$492,577.80; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that it is in the best interest of the County to waive the Request for Proposals (RFP) Process as the system is currently in place and has been in use for five years; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed the form of agreement and has examined it as to both form and content and desires to enter into it.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED, that the Request for Proposals (RFP) Process is waived and the District Attorney or his designee is authorized to execute the Agreement with Axon Enterprise, Inc.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the District Attorney or his designee is authorized and directed to execute subsequent amendments to the executed Agreement which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
