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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH DALY CITY PENINSULA PARTNERSHIP COLLABORATIVE TO PROVIDE ACADEMIC SUPPORT FOR YOUTH IN NORTHERN SAN MATEO COUNTY, EXTENDING THE TERM THROUGH JUNE 30, 2021 AND ADDING \$222,895 IN FUNDS FOR A REVISED TOTAL OBLIGATION NOT TO EXCEED \$433,015

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, many families in the northern region San Mateo County are recent immigrants, and children of those families have struggled to achieve grade-level proficiency for Common Core standards; and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency (HSA) has identified the need for comprehensive Out-of-School Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math programs in the northern region of San Mateo County; and

WHEREAS, Daly City Peninsula Partnership Collaborative (DCPPC) leverages the funding provided by HSA with funding from fee-based programs, four school districts, and Silicon Valley Community Foundation to support after school academic programs, pre-kindergarten programs, and community events that serve Daly City and South San Francisco youth and their families; and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2017, by Resolution 075391, this Board authorized an agreement with DCPPC to provide academic support for youth in northern San

Mateo County for the term of September 1, 2017 through June 30, 2019 for a total amount not to exceed \$210,120; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an amendment to the agreement with DCPCC, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, to add \$222,895 for a revised amount not to exceed \$433,015 and extend the term from September 1, 2017 through June 30, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said amendment to agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
