RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A “NO PARKING” ZONE ON SKYLINE BOULEVARD IN UNINCORPORATED SAN MATEO COUNTY

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 22507 et al. and Section 7.30.010 of the County of San Mateo Ordinance Code allow the Board of Supervisors to establish parking zones that prohibit or restrict the stopping, parking, or standing of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works (Department) received a request from the Sheriff’s Office to restrict parking on a portion of Skyline Boulevard due to illegal dumping of garbage and individuals sleeping in vehicles overnight; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works concurs with the recommendation establishing a “No Parking” zone on a portion of Skyline Boulevard to support public safety and discourage dumping of refuse; and

WHEREAS, this Board has reviewed and concurs with the recommendation of the Director of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FURTHER DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:
a “No Parking” zone be established at the following location:

Commencing 40 feet south of the centerline of Skyline Boulevard (Road No. 101A) at Golf Course Drive (Road No. 103) then traveling south on both sides of the road of Skyline Boulevard for 4,500 feet, more or less.
