RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR

The Permanent Protection of Camp Jones Gulch in La Honda

*WHEREAS, the new partnership between Sempervirens Fund and The YMCA of San Francisco will permanently protect the 928-acre property that **Camp Jones Gulch** has occupied for more than 80 years in La Honda, California, and;*

WHEREAS, the partnership enables the state's oldest land trust to permanently preserve land that is home to one of the largest unprotected stands of old-growth redwoods in the Santa Cruz mountains, and;

*WHEREAS, since 1968 more than 1 million children from San Mateo County and surrounding areas have experienced outdoor education at The Y's **Camp Jones Gulch**, and;*

WHEREAS, the partnership protects seven unique habitats and helps mitigate the extreme consequences of wildfire through stewardship and active management.

***NOW, THEREFORE; BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Supervisors of San Mateo County does hereby fully support the permanent protection of **Camp Jones Gulch in La Honda** through a partnership between Sempervirens Fund and The YMCA of San Francisco.*
