**MEASURE K: RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY, OR  
DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE A MEASURE K GRANT AGREEMENT WITH CORA  
(COMMUNITY OVERCOMING RELATIONSHIP ABUSE) FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE  
SAFEHOUSE SHELTER SERVICES, FOR A TERM OF JULY 1, 2026 THROUGH  
JUNE 30, 2027, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$170,000  
FUNDED BY MEASURE K**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, domestic violence impacts thousands of San Mateo County residents each year and is a critical public health and safety concern; and

**WHEREAS**, CORA (Community Overcoming Relationship Abuse) operates the only confidential residential safehouse facility for domestic violence survivors and their children in San Mateo County, providing a 28-bed facility at an undisclosed location that operates 365 days per year; and

**WHEREAS**, CORA's safehouse provides survivors of domestic violence and their families with confidential residential shelter, meals, case management, safety planning, and systems navigation to help them rebuild their lives; and

**WHEREAS**, the County wishes to formalize a one-year collaboration with CORA to provide confidential residential safehouse management and support services, including emergency shelter, case management, advocacy, and facility management

services. A wavier of competitive procurement requirements has been approved for this agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has been presented with an agreement with CORA as described in the Board Memorandum accompanying this resolution, in an amount not to exceed \$170,000 for a term of July 1, 2026 through June 30, 2027, and has examined it and approved it as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the District Attorney or their designee is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement with CORA.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the District Attorney or designee is authorized to exercise the contractual options set forth in the agreements at their sole discretion, and is further authorized execute amendments to the agreements which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate per agreement), and/or modify the contract term and/or services, so long as the modified contract term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
