This is to confirm that San Mateo County Fire Department is being awarded \$298,755 from CAL FIRE's and California Climate Investments, Direct Funding program for Fire Prevention activities. This money is to reimburse the County for purchasing 2 pieces of equipment to be used on Fire Prevention programs in the Santa Cruz Mountains. Specifically, a Cat 309 Excavator with masticating head and a 500-gallon water trailer shall be purchased with those funds.

At the same time, CAL FIRE will also be reimbursing San Cruz County Fire Department for a Brush Bandit 250XP Track Chipper and an Equipment trailer capable of hauling this chipper or the Excavator, from the same funding source. This equipment will also be used for Fire Prevention programs in the Santa Cruz Mountains. This equipment is expected to be to be utilized on projects throughout the Santa Cruz Mountains benefiting both counties.

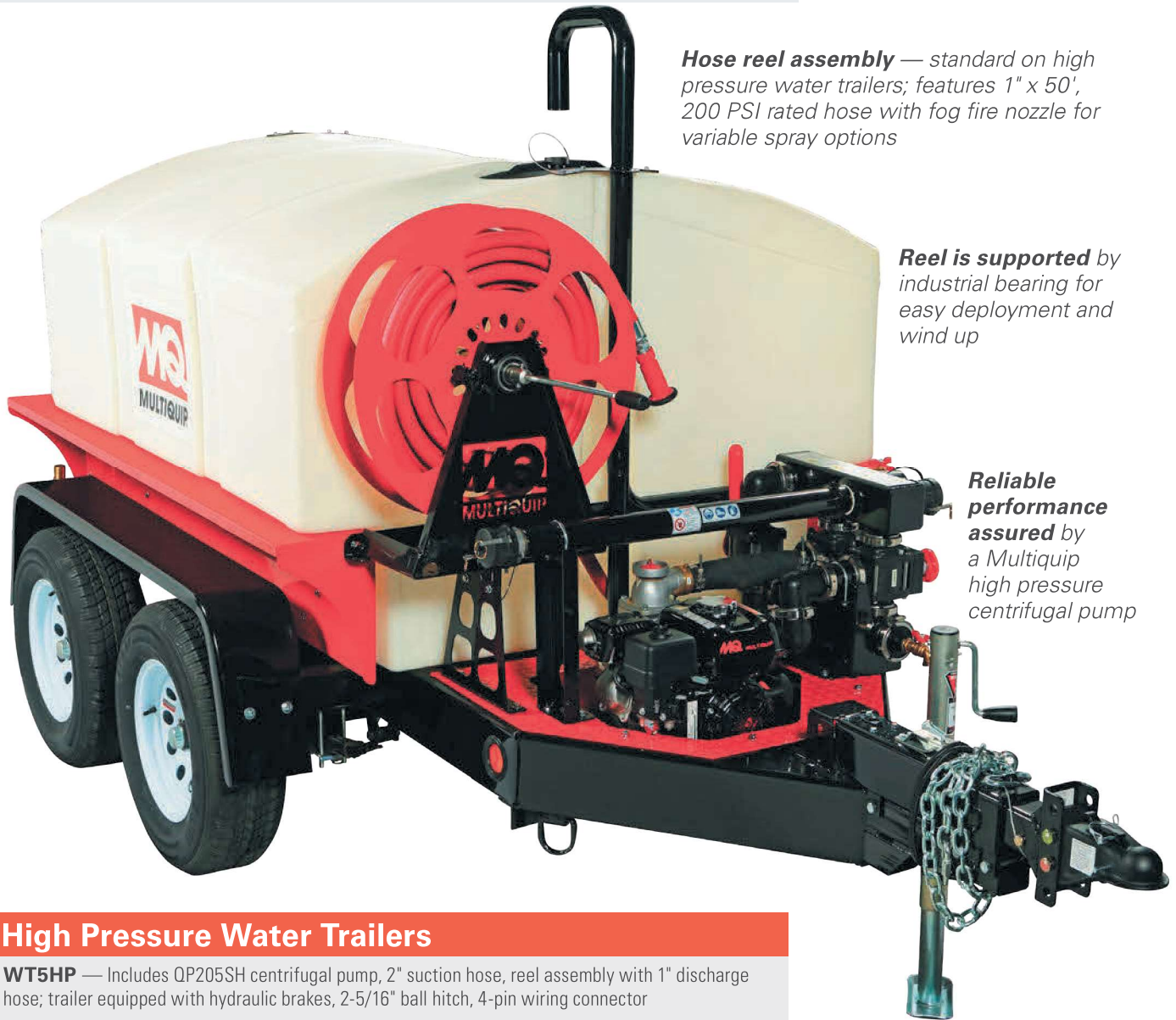
