WHEREAS, BILL SOMERVILLE continued to innovate the field of philanthropy, authoring Grassroots Philanthropy: Field Notes of a Maverick Grantmaker, consulting with over 400 community and family foundations, teaching philanthropy at Stanford University, giving a TED Talk at Brigham Young University, and mentoring many philanthropic and community leaders; and

WHEREAS, BILL SOMERVILLE has left a lasting legacy in San Mateo County and philanthropy nationally, elevating the spirit of radical collaboration, innovation, and commitment to investment in communities and people in greatest need.
