RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT WITH CRAWFORD AND ASSOCIATES, INC., FOR CONTINUED GEOTECHNICAL INVESTIGATIONS AND GEOLOGICAL HAZARD SERVICES TO THE SAN MATEO MEDICAL CENTER RENOVATION PROJECT, INCREASING THE CONTRACT AMOUNT BY \$50,000 FOR A NEW NOT TO EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$250,000, WITH NO CHANGE TO THE TERM

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo Medical Center Renovation Project is a multi-phase capital construction project that consists of demolition, ground up construction, renovation, and reconfiguration; and

WHEREAS, since February 2020, Crawford and Associates, Inc. has been working under contract with the Medical Center construction project team to move the project forward and has delivered geotechnical analysis and reports that have been reviewed and approved by HCAI; and

WHEREAS, the County and Crawford and Associates, Inc. wish to execute an amendment to their existing agreement to increase the maximum amount authorized to be expended by \$50,000, to allow the continuation of geotechnical services through the project completion.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors is authorized and directed to execute an amendment to the Agreement with Crawford and Associates, Inc. to increase the contract amount of \$50,000 for a new not to exceed amount of \$250,000 for continued geotechnical investigations and geological hazard services to the San Mateo Medical Center Renovation project.

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the Interim Director of the Project Development Unit, or designee, is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 in aggregate and/or modify the contract terms and/or services so long as the modified terms or services are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
