**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO TO ACCEPT A \$1,000,000 GRANT FROM THE CALIFORNIA STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD AND ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT TO FUND THE PESCADERO CREEK WATERSHED ROADS SEDIMENT REDUCTION PROJECT**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the County is committed to protecting its natural resources which includes a commitment to the stormwater program goals to improve water quality, reduce pollution, and comply with the regional permit; and

**WHEREAS**, the County submitted an application to the State Water Resources Control Board for funding for the Pescadero Creek Watershed Roads Sediment Reduction Project (Project); and

**WHEREAS**, the County was awarded a California State Water Resources Control Board (Water Board) Nonpoint Source Grant Program competitive grant to fund the Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the grant purpose is to protect and restore water quality and aquatic habitat of the Pacific Ocean and its watersheds through the implementation of culvert repair and road stabilization strategies in an impaired watershed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sustainability Department, Department of Public Works (DPW), and Parks Department (Parks) will collaborate to repair and upgrade four stream

crossings on tributaries to Pescadero Creek, including Bloomquist Creek, Peterson Creek, Schenley Creek, and Rhododendron Creek, to reduce chronic and episodic sediment delivery in accordance with the Pescadero-Butano Watershed Sediment Total Maximum Daily Loads plan; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 9, 2025, this Board adopted Resolution 081584 to authorize moving forward with the grant and Project; and

**WHEREAS**, the Water Board required the County to update language in Resolution 081584 before completing the grant, which is effectuated by this Resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Director - Sustainability Department, or designee, is hereby authorized and designated to sign, for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, the funding agreement for the Project and any amendments thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED** that the Director - Sustainability Department, or designee, is hereby authorized and designated to represent the County of San Mateo in carrying out its responsibilities under the funding agreement, including approving and signing invoices and requests for reimbursement of Project costs.

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
