RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING

Kevin Bryant

Upon His Retirement from the Town of Woodside

WHEREAS, Kevin Bryant has served the town of Woodside since 2008, stepping into the role as Town Manager in 2012; and

WHEREAS, Kevin Bryant leaves the Town of Woodside in strong fiscal health having reinforced reserves, built trust accounts to resist dramatic shifts in PERS rates, modified retiree health benefits for long term savings, increased sewer rates to build sewer enterprise funds, and updated the Town’s schedule of fees and charges to be regularly set to increase with CPI over time; and

WHEREAS, Kevin Bryant rose to the challenge of the COVID pandemic, leading the Town staff and communicating with the public, facilitating transparent public meetings through the use of videoconferencing technology, and moving to an online permitting and payment system; and

WHEREAS, Kevin Bryant spearheaded various key infrastructure projects, including constructing the first path in the Glens, completing renovation of the Woodside Library, rebuilding the Town Center Sewer Pump Station and the bridges on Old La Honda and Portola Roads, supported the Old La Honda Road co-op to build out broadband, and installed EV chargers and solar panels at Town Hall; and

WHEREAS, Kevin Bryant during his tenure as Town Manager, has worked alongside 17 different council members, oversaw the shift from at-wide to district elections, and the reduction in size of the Town Council, Planning Commission and Architectural and Site Review Board; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby honors and commends Kevin Bryant on 17 years of exemplary service and leadership with the Town of Woodside and extends its congratulations and best wishes in retirement.
