A Qualified Archaeologist Shall Monitor Project Activities on Cloverdale Road (Site No. 190)</b></p> <p>Prior to the onset of construction activities, the County shall retain a qualified archaeologist, per the Secretary of Interior’s Standards (36 CFR § 800.2(a)(1)), to monitor all ground disturbing activity during construction at the Project site located on Cloverdale Road (Site No. 190). The consulting archaeologist will determine the most suitable levels of monitoring (e.g., full time or spot checking) based on the proposed types of construction activities. In addition, the consulting archaeologist shall have the authority, with the County’s approval, to discontinue monitoring if the project activities will no longer have the potential to cause adverse effects to archaeological deposits (e.g., activities occurring directly in the streambed).</p> <p>In the event that cultural resources are exposed during construction, the monitor shall temporarily halt activities in the immediate vicinity of the discovery while it is evaluated for significance and communicate</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1.
