



Mission: maintain, enhance and improve the quality of life for older adults in San Mateo County







CoA: Review and approval of the Area Plan

2023-24 OAA funds: \$4,383,760 \$2,922,354 = 67% for meals

- Over 60: **201,581** people
- = 26.4 % of the population
- Living in poverty*: **15,035** people over 60

- \$15 for each person over 60 for meals
- \$7 per older adult for everything else*





^{*}less than \$14,580/year in 2023 for a single person

^{*}adult day health care, transportation, information and assistance, legal assistance, Ombudsman program, disease prevention, and family care giver program.

- OAA: CoA must carry out
- "advisory functions which further the area agency's mission of developing and coordinating community-based systems of services for all older individuals and family and older relative caregivers specific to each planning and service area."

- OCA: CoA is the
- "principal advocate body on behalf of older individuals within a planning and service area"
