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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING: A) THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS TO PROVIDE CORE SERVICE AGENCY SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2025, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2028, IN THE FOLLOWING AMOUNTS: (1) COASTSIDE HOPE, \$1,233,825; (2) DALY CITY PENINSULA PARTNERSHIP COLLABORATIVE, \$3,397,566; (3) PACIFICA RESOURCE CENTER, \$892,245; (4) PUENTE DE LA COSTA SUR, \$388,041; (5) SAMARITAN HOUSE, \$5,157,570; (6) SAMARITAN HOUSE (SOUTH COUNTY PROGRAM), \$1,012,803; (7) YOUNG MEN'S CHRISTIAN ASSOCIATION (YMCA) OF SAN FRANCISCO, \$2,059,512; AND B) THE HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY DIRECTOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE CORE AGENCY SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF JULY 1, 2025, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2028, WITH THE CITY OF REDWOOD CITY (FAIR OAKS COMMUNITY CENTER) FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$1,793,282.40

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Core Service Agencies provide critical safety net services to vulnerable, low-income San Mateo County residents, including emergency food and referrals to food services, emergency financial assistance (including from paying rent, utilities, security despots, etc.), information on housing resources, transportation assistance, and referrals to the Coordinated Entry System, through which residents experiencing homelessness are assessed and connected to homeless services; and

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2025, the Human Services Agency (HSA) issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Core Service Agency services and using the criteria outlined in the RFP, selected multiple agencies to provide Core Services throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, HSA is requesting that the Board authorize agreements with each of the Core Service Agencies listed in the title of this resolution to provide safety net services for the term of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2028, for a total allocation amount of \$15,934,844.40 for Core services; and

WHEREAS, HSA is further requesting the Board authorize the Director of the Human Services Agency, or designee, to execute an agreement with the City of Redwood City to accommodate their contract review and execution process.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreements and this Board also authorizes the Director of the Human Services Agency, or designee, to execute an agreement with the City of Redwood City for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.
