WHEREAS, Clyde Edward Beffa, Jr. was born and raised in San Mateo County, went to elementary and middle school at St. Gregory’s in San Mateo and to high school at Junipero Serra High School before receiving his degree in AG Economics from UC Davis; and

WHEREAS, Clyde Edward Beffa, Jr., upon graduating, was gifted a dairy farm in Tracy by his grandfather where he and his bride moved and raised their first child and ran the dairy farm, until returning to the Coastsides in 1980 and settling into their Purisima Canyon home, which had been home for generations of his family before him; and

WHEREAS, his love of wine led him and his childhood best friend, Todd Zucker, to open K&L Liquors in 1976, which grew and expanded over the decades and eventually became known as K&L Wine Merchants, until he sold the business in 2024 to enjoy a well-earned retirement; and

WHEREAS, in addition to running a successful business and traveling the world, **Clyde Edward Beffa, Jr.** and his family are proud members of our Coastsides community, and Clyde served as a founding board member of the Table of Plenty, which serves a weekly community meal at Senior Coastsiders, providing healthy food to any member of the community who is hungry for a meal or looking for companionship, and hosting the annual Table of Plenty Wine Tasting Fundraiser, which helps raise funds to continue the tradition he helped start in 2013; and


