BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OR HIS DESIGNEE, DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, TO SUBMIT GRANT APPLICATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES (OES) FOR THE FY 2025-2027 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE GRANTS (EMPG), WHICH APPLICATIONS AND ANY SUBSEQUENT AGREEMENTS WILL NOT EXCEED A TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$759,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Department of Emergency Management wishes to apply to the State for grant funding which will enhance the local operational area's capabilities to plan, train and exercise for, respond to and mitigate and recover from all hazards; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services requires the Grantee to certify by resolution that the Governing Body approves of submission of an application to the State; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services has received funding allocations for the operational areas to enhance the capabilities of local emergency managers and partners to expand operational readiness, respond to incidents, enhance emergency planning, training, exercise, preparedness, and improve resiliency in the community;

WHEREAS, The San Mateo County Department of Emergency Management will serve as the administrator for any Emergency Management Performance Grants awarded by the Governor's Office of Emergency Services through FY 2027 with the total amount not to exceed \$759,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the County Executive and/or the Director of the San Mateo County Department of Emergency Management to submit grant applications to the Governor's Office of Emergency Services for administration of the FY 2025 through FY 2027 Emergency Management Performance Grant Program in the amount totaling \$759,000 and execute on behalf of the County of San Mateo all necessary applications, contracts, agreements, amendments, payment requests, and grant assurances related thereto for the purposes of securing funds and implementing and carrying out the purposes specified in the grant application.

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
