## First Amendment to Agreement Between the County of San Mateo and David Martin, MD for Urology Services

THIS AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into and effective upon the date last executed below, by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called "County," and **David Martin, MD**, hereinafter called "Contractor";

## WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, the parties entered into an agreement for urology services for the term of October 1, 2024 through September 30, 2027, in an amount not to exceed \$ 2,416,860.00 (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to add additional clinic coverage time to the Agreement to satisfy patient care needs; and

WHEREAS, the amount payable under the Agreement must be increased by \$187,776.00 to accommodate the additional clinic services;

## NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. <u>EXHIBIT A</u> (entitled **SERVICES**), Section II., subsection a. (entitled **Clinic Blocks**) is amended to read as follows:
  - a. **Clinic Blocks**: In each Contract Year, Contractor shall perform two hundred eighty-eight (288) four-hour (4 hr.) Urology clinics ("Clinic Blocks).
- 2. <u>EXHIBIT B</u> (entitled **PAYMENTS**), Section I. of the Agreement (entitled is amended to read as follows:
  - I. Total payment for services under this Agreement will not exceed TWO MILLION SIX HUNDRED FOUR THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED THIRTY-SIX DOLLARS (\$2,604,636.00).
