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**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FY 2020-21 RECOMMENDED BUDGET
SUBMITTED BY THE COUNTY MANAGER**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the County Budget Act (Government Code §§ 29000-29144 and § 30200) requires that each county have a Recommended Budget, approved by its Board of Supervisors, in place on July 1 of each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2020, the County Manager posted the FY 2020-21 Recommended Budget on the County's Budget, Policy, and Performance webpage accessible to the public; and

WHEREAS, this Board has held public budget hearings on the FY 2020-21 Recommended Budget on June 23, 2020, during which time testimony was taken from County officers, employees, and/or members of the public; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2020-21 Recommended Budget submitted herewith includes such revisions deemed necessary for the purpose of having authority to spend until the budget is formally adopted in September 2020 and contains estimates of Fund Balances which will be finalized after the June budget hearings and upon the conclusion of FY 2019-20 year-end closing activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that:

1. The budget recommended by the County Manager for Fiscal Year 2020-21, including all fixed assets and revisions, and approved by this Board during its public hearings, shall be the Recommended Budget of the County of San Mateo for Fiscal Year 2020-21; and

2. All final Fiscal Year 2019-20 Fund Balance adjustments shall be part of the FY 2020-21 Recommended Budget and shall be made in accordance with the County Reserves Policy and Fund Balance guidelines; and

3. The time for adoption of the FY 2020-21 budget shall be extended to no later than October 2, 2020, and expenditures until that time shall be made in accordance with the Recommended Budget.

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
