**RESOLVED,** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, section 206b(1) of the San Mateo County Charter authorizes the Board of Supervisors to abolish any appointive office; and

WHEREAS, section 206a(4) of the San Mateo County Charter authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish the number of all appointed officers and employees and provide for their powers and duties; and

WHEREAS, sections 206a(5) and 508 of the San Mateo County Charter authorize the Board of Supervisors to establish by ordinance or resolution the compensation and benefits of County officers and employees; and

WHEREAS, San Mateo County Ordinance No. 073703 ordered that henceforth the number of County appointed officers and employees and their compensation and benefits shall be established by resolution of the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the best interest of the County to abolish the classification of B421, Sheriff's Executive Director of Administration – Unclassified and to amend the Master Salary Resolution and its Job Table to remove the salary range for the classification of B421 Sheriff's Executive Director of Administration.

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors abolishes the classification of B421, Sheriff's Executive Director of Administration – Unclassified.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the Master Salary Resolution and its Job Table are amended to remove the salary range for the classification of B421 Sheriff's Executive Director of Administration – Unclassified.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT** these actions are effective immediately upon adoption of this resolution.
