**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH TOTAL RENAL CARE, INC.  
TO PROVIDE ACUTE CARE DIALYSIS, CONTINUOUS AMBULATORY  
PERITONEAL DIALYSIS, AND CLINICAL APHERESIS SERVICES FOR THE TERM  
OF MARCH 1, 2022 THROUGH FEBRUARY 28, 2025, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO  
EXCEED \$3,000,000**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, San Mateo County is responsible for providing medical care to its medically indigent adult population, including acute inpatient dialysis treatment at San Mateo Medical Center (SMMC); and

**WHEREAS**, in August 2021, SMMC completed a Request for Proposals; and

**WHEREAS**, Total Renal Care, Inc., formerly known as Davita Inc., has been providing SMMC with high quality dialysis care since 1999 and was elevated again due to their price, quality, and ability to provide a local team to cater positive patient experience through their services; and

**WHEREAS**, both parties wish to enter into an agreement to provide acute care dialysis, continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis, and clinical apheresis services for the term of March 1, 2022 through February 28, 2025, in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
