WHEREAS, Steve Picchi served in the US Army reserves from 1968 to 1974 and was honorably discharged as a staff sergeant of the Corps of Engineers division; and

WHEREAS, **Steve Picchi** retired from Pacific Gas and Electric Company in 2004 after 38 years serving the Coastside as a Senior Engineering Estimator and his last five years as Construction Supervisor, and also serving on the Half Moon Bay Planning Commission; and


WHEREAS, **Steve Picchi** joined the Half Moon Bay Lion Club July 1st, 1970, following in the footsteps of his father and Uncle Frank who were Half Moon Bay Lions Club charter members, and having held numerous leadership positions in the local club, as well on the district and state levels before taking the high-ranking position of district governor in 2013 after being a 43-year member; and

WHEREAS, **Steve Picchi** has been active in the Lions Club now for over five decades, supporting youth sports, taking part in the club's regular senior citizens brunch and with Seniors Night Out, helping support the local Boys and Girls Club by erecting lighting for local sports fields and Scholarship programs for the high school students, flipping pancakes at the 4th of July pancake breakfast, shucking corn and cooking hamburgers at the Pumpkin Festival, barbecuing for Poker Night, and helping with the St. Vincent de Paul Second Harvest food delivery; and

WHEREAS, Steve Picchi's greatest accomplishment as a Lion member may be his pivotal involvement of spearheading successful Lions Club fundraisers in coordination with the Boys and Girls Club committee raising a quarter of a million dollars towards the construction of the building on Kelly Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Steve Picchi, along with his brother Rich, was a successful amateur winemaker for over twenty years, donating their wines to charity and fundraising events to support local schools, the Coastside Volunteer Fire Department and the Lions Eye Foundation., and having dedicated 55 years of volunteerism alongside his brother Rich Picchi.
