RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE OR THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO FACILITATE THE SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY, EACH WITH AN ESTIMATED VALUE EXCEEDING \$10,000

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, County Ordinance Code Section 2.83.130 (Disposal of Unneeded Personal Property) provides that when personal property is, in the opinion of the County Executive, surplus and not needed by the County, the County Executive may dispose of such property. However, where the value of the property exceeds \$10,000, the County Executive shall report such fact to the Board and obtain the Board's approval prior to disposing of it; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is in possession of the surplus property from County departments, as listed in Exhibit A, and wishes to auction said property; and

WHEREAS, the best interest of the County will be served by authorizing the sale of the surplus property.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the County Executive, or the County Executive's designee, to sell the surplus property listed in Exhibit A through public auction to the highest bidder.
