RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING

WHEREAS, as a former prosecutor with the Contra Costa County District Attorney’s Office, **Assemblymember Catherine Stefani** was later elected and sworn in as District 2 San Francisco County Board Supervisor in 2018 and served until 2024; and

WHEREAS, her experience as a prosecutor, policy analyst, and county supervisor has made **Assemblymember Catherine Stefani** an effective leader, working hard to create safer, more affordable communities, and ensuring that government works for all. In addition, during her time on the Board, she focused heavily on improving community policing, enhancing first responder readiness, and supporting families, as well as championing affordable housing initiatives, fighting for humane solutions to homelessness, and prioritizing investments in education and public safety; and

WHEREAS, **Assemblymember Catherine Stefani** was elected to California’s 19th Assembly District in 2024, which spans the westside of San Francisco, as well as the communities of Broadmoor, Colma, Daly City, and parts of South San Francisco and San Bruno; and

WHEREAS, **Assemblymember Catherine Stefani’s** lifelong advocacy for public safety has allowed her to author legislation and work on issues addressing gun violence, domestic violence, and corruption at the state level; and

WHEREAS, for the past year, **Assemblymember Catherine Stefani** has vigorously represented the residents of the counties of San Mateo and San Francisco, and as a member of the Assembly Local Government Committee, understands the impacts state finances have on local government operations; and

WHEREAS, **Assemblymember Catherine Stefani**, working in tandem with San Mateo County delegation members, was instrumental in securing \$76,572,000 million in Vehicle Licensing Fee shortfall funding for the 20 municipalities of San Mateo County and the County of San Mateo, which has helped maintain essential county services, including homeless shelter operations, housing subsidies, farmworker housing, climate change and sea level rise initiatives, and wildfire prevention efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby honors and commends **Assemblymember Catherine Stefani** for her service, leadership, and tireless dedication to San Mateo County.
