WHEREAS, the California State Association of Counties recognizes the HOME application as one of the 14 winners of the 2023 Challenge Awards;

WHEREAS, the Challenge Awards recognize initiatives from California Counties that find new, effective, and efficient ways to provide programs and services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, hereby honors and congratulates the **County Information Services Department** and **Human Services Agency** as 2023 Challenge Awardees.
