**RESOLUTION:**

- A) AUTHORIZING A GRANT TO STREETCODE ACADEMY IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,000 TO SUPPORT THE DEVELOPMENT OF STREETCODE;  
AND**
- B) AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT WITH STREETCODE ACADEMY FOR THE TERM JUNE 23, 2026 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2027, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$400,000; AND**
- C) AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, OR DESIGNEE(S), IN CONSULTATION WITH THE COUNTY ATTORNEY, TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE ANY RELATED DOCUMENTS WITH STREETCODE ACADEMY AND/OR DESIGNATED IMPLEMENTING PARTNER(S) TO SUPPORT THE INNOVATION PODS LEARNING CAMPUS PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND PROGRAMMING**

**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, the County of San Mateo is committed to advancing educational attainment, workforce readiness, economic mobility, and equitable access to opportunity for residents of all ages; and

**WHEREAS**, StreetCode Academy is a community-based organization located in East Palo Alto that has served the community by providing culturally responsive technology education, digital literacy, workforce development, and entrepreneurship programming; and

**WHEREAS**, StreetCode Academy proposes to develop the Innovation Pods Learning Campus, a permanent community-centered learning campus designed to

expand access to technology education, workforce development, innovation, and career pathways for youth, families, and seniors throughout San Mateo County (“Project”); and

**WHEREAS**, the Project will transform approximately 6,500 square feet of underutilized land into flexible learning spaces, including classrooms, a makerspace, and technology-enabled environments that support hands-on learning, digital skill development, entrepreneurship, and workforce readiness; and

**WHEREAS**, the County’s total investment of \$400,000 in the form of a grant will provide \$450,000 to support StreetCode Academy’s Project development and capital costs associated with the Innovation Pods Learning Campus to support program development and launch activities to ensure high-quality educational and workforce programming is available when the Innovation Pods Learning Campus opens (“Grant”).

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Grant in an amount not to exceed \$400,000, which amount includes \$400,000 to support StreetCode Academy’s Innovation Pods Learning Campus.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Executive, or designee(s), in consultation with the County Attorney, is authorized and directed to negotiate and execute a Grant agreement and any related documents, amendments, and certificates with StreetCode Academy and/or designated implementing partner(s) necessary to support the Project and programming.
