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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH FAMILY CONNECTIONS
FOR CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION SERVICES, FOR THE TERM OF OCTOBER 1,
2023 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026 AND A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$989,855**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, in March 2023, the Human Services Agency (HSA) issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to identify providers of child abuse prevention services to at-risk families with children ages zero (0) to eighteen (18) and Family Connections was selected based on their capacity, experience, and method of providing the services; and

WHEREAS, HSA requests to enter into an agreement with Family Connections to provide evidence-based parent education, and short-term clinical services through Family Resource Hubs that will serve families who are enrolled in, or have contact with, Family Connections' early-childhood education centers located in Daly City, Redwood City (North Fair Oaks Region), and East Palo Alto; and

WHEREAS, the goal of these services is to help parents learn positive parenting skills, have their behavioral and mental health needs met, and their children will develop the skills necessary to succeed in kindergarten and beyond; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an agreement with Family Connections, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, for an amount not to exceed \$989,855 for the term of October 1, 2023 through June 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate), and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
