BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING: A) CONSOLIDATING THE STATEWIDE DIRECT PRIMARY ELECTION, TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 3, 2014, WITH ELECTIONS CALLED BY THE BAYSHORE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT, CABRILLO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT, SEQUOIA UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT, WOODSIDE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL DISTRICT, CITY OF HALF MOON BAY, GRANADA SANITARY DISTRICT, AND MIDPENINSULA REGIONAL OPEN SPACE DISTRICT; AND B) THE COUNTY'S CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER TO RENDER SPECIFIED ELECTION SERVICES IN CONJUNCTION THEREWITH

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, Sections 10400 through 10418 of the California Elections Code authorizes the consolidation of elections that are called to be held on the same day in or within the same territory upon the order of the governing body or bodies calling the elections, the consolidation may be ordered by the County Board of Supervisors upon request, and the consolidated election shall be held in all respects as if it were one election, with the returns being canvassed by the County's Chief Elections Officer;

WHEREAS, absent other arrangements or applicable law, the costs of any school district election shall be borne by the school district holding the election pursuant to Section 5421 of the California Education Code, and any city or district shall reimburse the County in full for the services performed by the County's Chief Elections Officer in accordance with Division 10 of the California Elections Code;

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the governing board of Bayshore Elementary School District adopted Resolution No. 13-12 giving notice of a special election to be held on June 3, 2014, for the purposes of submitting a bond measure to District voters and requesting that this Board of Supervisors authorize the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the governing board of Cabrillo Unified School District adopted Resolution No. 06-14 giving notice of a special election to be held on June 3, 2014, for the purposes of submitting a parcel tax measure to District voters and requesting that this Board of Supervisors authorize the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the governing board of Sequoia Union High School District adopted Resolution No. 1508 giving notice of a special election to be held on June 3, 2014, for the purposes of submitting a bond measure to District voters and requesting that this Board of Supervisors authorize the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the governing board of Woodside Elementary School District adopted Resolution No. 2014-06 giving notice of a special election to be held on June 3, 2014, for the purposes of submitting a bond measure to District voters and requesting that this Board of Supervisors authorize the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the City Council of the City of Half Moon Bay adopted Resolution No. 2014-11 giving notice of a special election to be held on June 3, 2014, for the purpose of submitting to the Half Moon Bay voters a measure relating to

the “Main Street Bridge Safety and Accessibility Act” and requesting that this Board of Supervisors authorize the County’s Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the City therefor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the City Council of the City of Half Moon Bay adopted Resolution No. 2014-12 giving notice of a special election to be held on June 3, 2014, for the purpose of submitting to the Half Moon Bay voters a measure relating to the “Main Street Bridge Preservation Act” and requesting that this Board of Supervisors authorize the County’s Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the City therefor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the governing board of the Local Agency Formation Commission, on behalf of Granada Sanitary District, adopted Resolution No. 1176 giving notice of a special election to be held on June 3, 2014, for the purposes of submitting a reorganization measure to District voters and requesting that this Board of Supervisors authorize the County’s Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor;

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, this Board in relation to the Granada Sanitary District reorganization question adopted Resolution No. 073051 ordering that the question be submitted to voters on June 3, 2014, and that the question be consolidated with the statewide election occurring on that date;

WHEREAS, pursuant to state law, the governing board of Midpeninsula Regional Open Space District adopted Resolution No. 2014-09 giving notice of a special election to be held on June 3, 2014, for the purposes of submitting a bond measure to District voters and requesting that this Board of Supervisors authorize the County’s Chief

Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor;

WHEREAS, the County's Chief Elections Officer is agreeable to providing specified election services as duly requested and enumerated above in conjunction with the Statewide Direct Primary Election to be held on Tuesday, June 3, 2014; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the services and supplies to be provided by the Chief Elections Officer in conducting said election, the above-named cities and districts as required by law will enter into separate agreements with the County's Chief Elections Officer to outline the services to be rendered and to reimburse the County for the costs of said services and supplies.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that (A) the June 3, 2014, Statewide Direct Primary Election is hereby consolidated with the above-named local elections duly called by their respective governing bodies; and (B) the Chief Elections Officer is authorized to render specified election services in conjunction therewith.

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
