








Adults Over 65 Population Growth Projection




Poverty Level by Age (2024)

● Above Poverty Level ● Below Poverty Level




% of Population Below Poverty (2024)



Average Unemployment Rate



Annual income by race/ethnicity and gender



Key Metric: Income Growth


Increase in wages for full-time and salary workers over 10 years.






% of Population Paying >50% of Income on Housing (Locations >25% of Population, 2019-2023)

% of **Low Income** Households Spending >30% of Income on Housing (Locations >10%, 2018-2022)






Renter Cost Burden


- Housing Affordability - Renter Cost Burden (30%)** shows the percentage of renters who spend 30% or more of their household income on rent.
- Key Findings**
 In 2023, there were 108,431 renter households in San Mateo County and 46% spent more than 30% of their income on rent.
 - 69% of Pacific Islander renter households, 60% of Latino/e/x, 57% of Native American, 41% of White, and 39% of Asian American renter households were rent burdened.











% of Households Receiving SNAP (2020-2024)
