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**RESOLUTION DECLARING UNCLAIMED MONIES IN THE COUNTY TREASURY
PROPERTY OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND TRANSFERRING SAID
UNCLAIMED MONIES TO THE TREASURER AND AGING AND ADULT SERVICES**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, there is currently on deposit with the Treasurer, of the County of San Mateo, in a fund entitled "Unknown Heirs," \$18,988.29. This money has remained unclaimed in the Treasury for over three years; and

WHEREAS, the Treasurer has caused appropriate notice to be published in the form and manner provided by Government Code Section 50050 and 50051 in the Pacifica Tribune, in the County of San Mateo; and

WHEREAS, the unclaimed monies in the amount of \$18,988.29 have become property of the County of San Mateo and with Board of Supervisor approval, in accordance with state statute, the unclaimed monies will be transferred from the special fund in which it has been deposited to the Treasurer and Aging and Adult Services, to be shared equally as unanticipated revenue.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors declare the unclaimed monies property of the County of San Mateo and transfer the unclaimed funds in equal amounts as unanticipated revenue to the Treasurer and Aging and Adult Services.

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
