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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH TOTAL RENAL CARE, INC.
TO PROVIDE ACUTE CARE DIALYSIS, CONTINUOUS AMBULATORY
PERITONEAL DIALYSIS, AND CLINICAL APHERESIS SERVICES FOR THE TERM
OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2025 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 2028, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO
EXCEED \$3,120,000**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, San Mateo County is responsible for providing medical care to its medically indigent adult population, including acute inpatient dialysis treatment for kidney disease at San Mateo Medical Center; and

WHEREAS, a Request for Proposals for acute care dialysis, continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis, and clinical apheresis services was completed in February of 2025; and

WHEREAS, Total Renal Care, Inc. (Total Renal) was elevated due to their price, quality, and ability to provide a local team to cater positive patient experience through their services; and

WHEREAS, the County and Total Renal wish to enter into an agreement whereby Total Renal will provide acute care dialysis, continuous ambulatory peritoneal dialysis, and clinical apheresis services for the term of September 1, 2025, through August 31, 2028, in an amount not to exceed \$3,120,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
