SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO AND SAMARITAN HOUSE – PACIFIC SHELTER

THIS SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT, entered into this date

June 10, 2025 , by and between the COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, hereinafter called

"County," and Project Samaritan House, hereinafter called "Contractor";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Government Code Section 31000, County may contract with independent contractors for the furnishing of such services to or for County or any Department thereof;

WHEREAS, on June 13, 2023, the parties entered into an agreement ("Agreement") for the term of July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2025, and a total obligation amount of \$4,414,580, to provide short-term emergency housing to single adults or adult couples at the Pacific Shelter located in Redwood City; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2024, the parties amended the Agreement ("First Amendment") to increase funding by \$251,904 for a new total obligation amount of \$4,666,484, and with no change to the term, to adjust the population to be served to include families with children; and

WHEREAS the parties wish to further amend the Agreement ("Second Amendment") to increase the term by 24 months for a new term of July 1, 2023 to June 30, 2027, and increase funding by \$4,414,580 for a new total obligation amount of \$9,081,064, to continue providing shelter services.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 3. Payments of the Agreement are amended to read as follows:

In consideration of the services provided by Contractor in accordance with all terms, conditions, and specifications set forth in this Agreement and in Exhibit A, County shall make payment to Contractor based on the rates and in the manner specified in Exhibit B. County reserves the right to withhold payment if County determines that the quantity or quality of the work performed is unacceptable. In no event shall County's total fiscal obligation under this Agreement exceed **NINE MILLION EIGHTY-ONE THOUSAND SIXTY-FOUR DOLLARS** (\$9,081,064). In the event that the County makes any advance payments, Contractor agrees to refund any amounts in excess of the amount owed by the County at the time of contract termination or expiration. Contractor is not entitled to payment for work not performed as required by this Agreement.

2. Section 4. Term.

Subject to compliance with all terms and conditions, the term of this Agreement shall be from July 1,2023, through June 30, 2027.
