RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING:

- 1. THE ACCEPTANCE OF CASH DONATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$210,197.45 FROM THE SAN MATEO COUNTY PARKS FOUNDATION AND \$7,961.84 FROM THE MOUNTED PATROL OF SAN MATEO COUNTY FOUNDATION; AND**
- 2. THE ACCEPTANCE OF IN-KIND DONATIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$138,725.00 FROM THE SAN MATEO COUNTY PARKS FOUNDATION**

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors highly values and appreciates financial contributions to the San Mateo County Parks Department (the "Parks Department"); and

WHEREAS, the San Mateo County Parks Foundation ("Parks Foundation") is providing \$210,197.45 in cash donations to the Parks Department for the 2025-26 Fiscal Year to help fund projects, programs, and events at various County parks; and

WHEREAS, the \$210,197.45 in cash donations from the Parks Foundation will be deposited in the Parks Department's Gifts and Donations revenue account and used as follows: \$2,517.00 for the Disc Golf Project at Coyote Point Park; \$28,866.45 for the Memorial Park Nature Center's 3D Topographical Map and Lighting Improvements; \$25,000.00 for Memorial Park Summer Naturalist Interns; \$25,300.00 for Bilingual Community Engagement Intern for Friendship and Flood Parks; \$15,000.00 for Bicycle Sunday; \$50,000.00 for Coyote Point Tree Health; \$10,000.00 for Habitat Restoration in

San Bruno Mountain State and County Park; \$14,500.00 for the Crystal Springs Regional Trail Fire Fuel Reduction Work; \$38,600.00 for Parks' Memorial Bench Program; and \$414.00 for Vehicle Entrance Passes for Events; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Foundation has provided in-kind donations totaling \$138,725.00 for various projects, programs, and events, including: \$18,000.00 for Volunteer Group Grants at various County parks; \$23,000.00 for Enhancing Equitable Access Grants at various County parks; \$9,792.00 for Annual Passes in Libraries throughout the county; \$4,500.00 for Disc Golf Project Support at Coyote Point Park; \$35,678.00 for Park Camping Trips and Bus Transportation for Field Trips; \$10,000.00 for a Flood Park Restroom Mural; \$186.00 for Parks Rx Prescriptions; \$15,698.00 for Special Event Support (e.g., SummerFest and Forest Therapy); \$4,371.00 for Stqry App Renewal and Stqry Kiosk at San Pedro Valley Park; \$15,000.00 for French Broom Removal at Huddart Park; and \$2,500.00 for Pavers for the Flood Park Playground; and

WHEREAS, the Parks Department received a cash donation of \$7,961.84 from the Mounted Patrol of San Mateo County Foundation to restore the bridge on Kings Mountain Trail near Greer Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors by adoption of this Resolution hereby authorizes the acceptance of cash donations in the amount of \$210,197.45, and in-kind donations in the amount of \$138,725.00, from the San Mateo County Parks Foundation and \$7,961.84 in cash donations from the Mounted Patrol of San Mateo County Foundation for FY 2025-26.
