**BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF SAN MATEO, STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

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**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH QUEST DIAGNOSTICS FOR DIAGNOSTIC LABORATORY REFERENCE TESTING SERVICES, FOR THE TERM OF NOVEMBER 1, 2025 THROUGH OCTOBER 31, 2030, IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$7,750,000**

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**RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

**WHEREAS**, Quest Diagnostics (“Quest”) is a member of the County’s competitively contracted Group Purchasing Organization (“GPO”), Vizient, who entices vendors to offer competitively priced services as a condition of accessing a large pool of purchasers; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the County to waive the competitive solicitation requirements set forth in County Administrative Memorandum B-1 because Quest is being sourced through the County’s GPO for reference laboratory services that San Mateo Medical Center’s laboratory can’t efficiently provide; and

**WHEREAS**, Quest is willing to provide reference laboratory services for the term of November 1, 2025 through October 31, 2030, in an amount not to exceed \$7,750,000; and

**WHEREAS**, this Board has been presented with a form of such agreement, has examined and approved it as both form and content, and desires to enter into it.

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED** that the competitive procurement requirements set forth in County Administrative Memorandum

B-1 is hereby waived due to the sourcing of the vendor through the County's existing GPO and the President of the Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief of San Mateo County Health or designee is authorized to execute contract amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in aggregate) and/or modify the contract term and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
