

Adoption of FY 2020-21 North Fair Oaks Garbage & Recycling Collection Charges Report for CSA-8

- Adoption of this report is part of an annual procedural process to place the minimum level of garbage and recycling collection service charges for dwellings onto the property taxes in CSA-8.
- In the early 1980's, the County began to place a minimum level of service charge for garbage collection services on the tax roll in CSA-8 for residential and commercial parcels.
- Per County Ordinance Code; any parcel that has a dwelling unit in CSA-8, is charged a minimum level for garbage service (two 32-gallon carts or one 64-gallon cart at the curb). This minimum charge is based upon units and is multiplied by the rates adopted by this Board in February.
- The charges are placed on the tax roll in accordance with County Ordinance Code.
- After the close of this public hearing, the next step is for your Board to Adopt the Resolution for the Collection Charges Report, which is then filed with the Controller's Office.
- The Controller's Office will then apply the charge amounts to the tax assessment roll for FY2020-21.
