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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT WITH ABODE SERVICES FOR SERVICE CONNECT RAPID RE-HOUSING SERVICES FOR THE TERM OF APRIL 9, 2024 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2025 FOR A TOTAL OBLIGATION NOT TO EXCEED \$910,608

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, stable housing plays a vital role in addressing significant reentry challenges for formerly incarcerated individuals and their families, and Employment Services has secured AB 109 Realignment funding to support Rapid-Rehousing Services (RRH); and

WHEREAS, in January 2024, the Human Services Agency released a Request for Proposals to identify a provider of RRH services for formerly incarcerated individuals and their families, and Abode Services (Abode) was selected because its experience, qualifications and program approach best meets the needs of the County; and

WHEREAS, under this agreement Abode Services will provide rapid re-housing services, including housing location services, temporary financial assistance, temporary case management and services, rental and moving assistance to formerly incarcerated individuals and their families; and

WHEREAS, there has been presented to this Board of Supervisors for its consideration and acceptance an agreement, reference to which is hereby made for further particulars, whereby Abode shall provide RRH program services for the term of April 9, 2024 through June 30, 2025 for a maximum obligation amount not to exceed \$910,608; and

WHEREAS, this Board of Supervisors has approved the agreement as to both form and content and desires to enter into the agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of this Board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of the Human Services Agency or designee is authorized to execute contract Amendments which modify the County's maximum fiscal obligation by no more than \$25,000 (in the aggregate), and/or modify the contract and/or services so long as the modified term or services is/are within the current or revised fiscal provisions.

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
