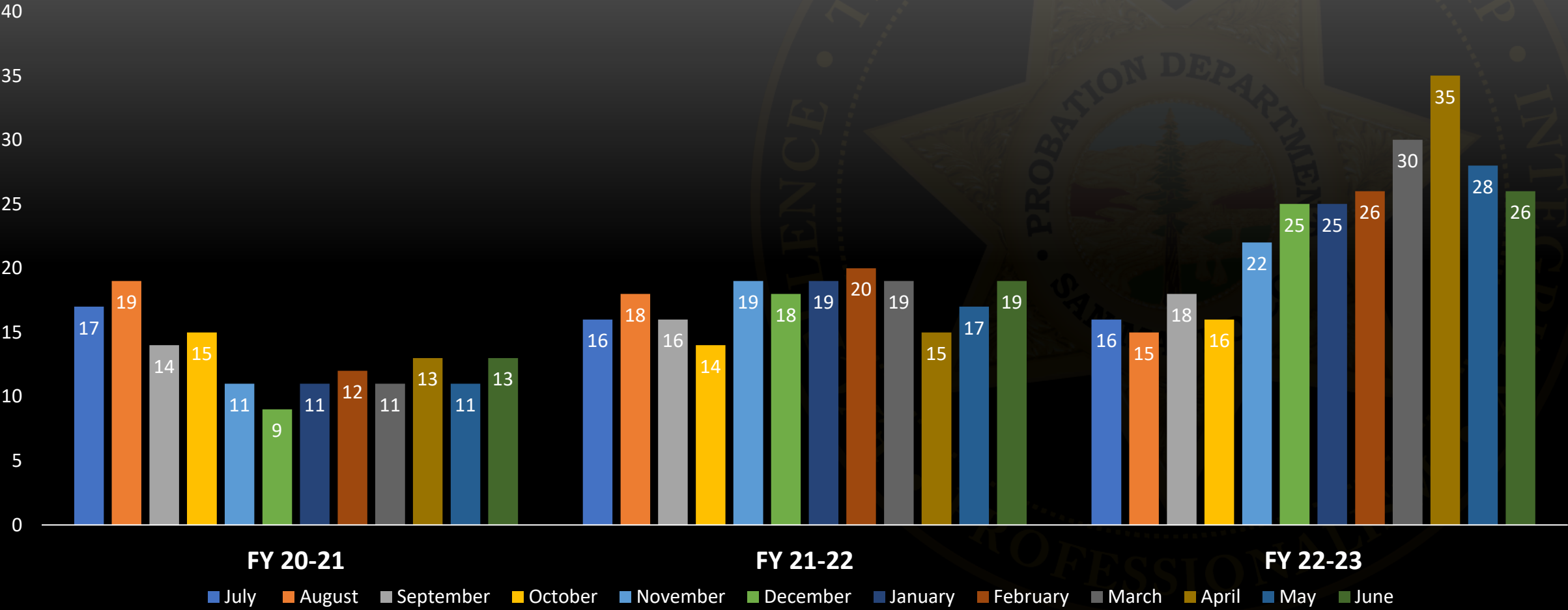

Purpose and Goals

- **Purpose:** Operate SMC's state-regulated juvenile detention facilities:
 - Youth Services Center-Juvenile Hall (YSC-JH)
 - Margaret J. Kemp Camp for Girls (Camp Kemp)
- **Goals:**
 - Provide safe and secure housing for youth and transitional aged youth detained by the court
 - Support each youth and their families
 - Aid in youths' rehabilitation and transition to the community

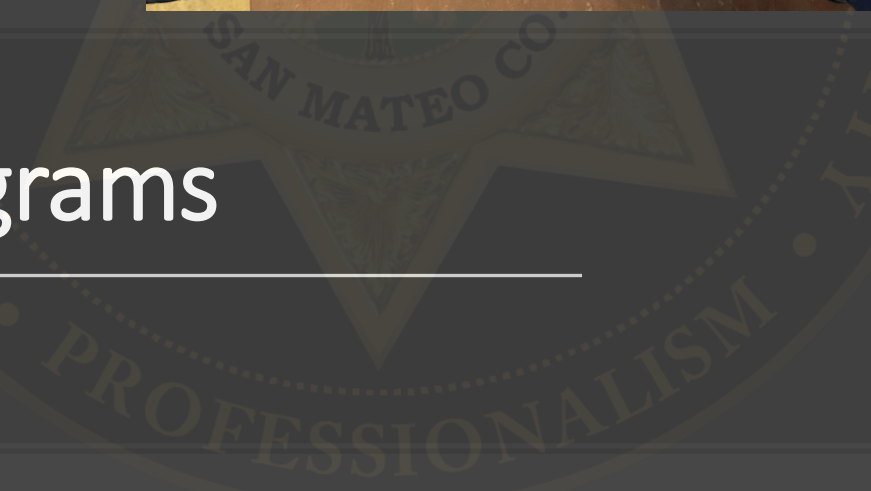

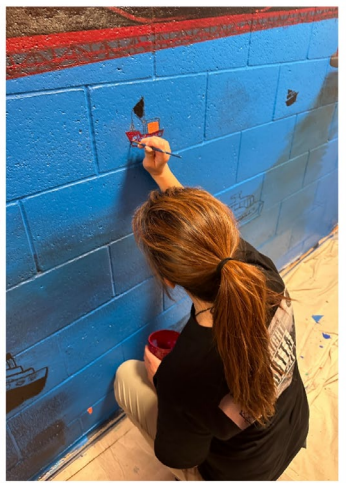
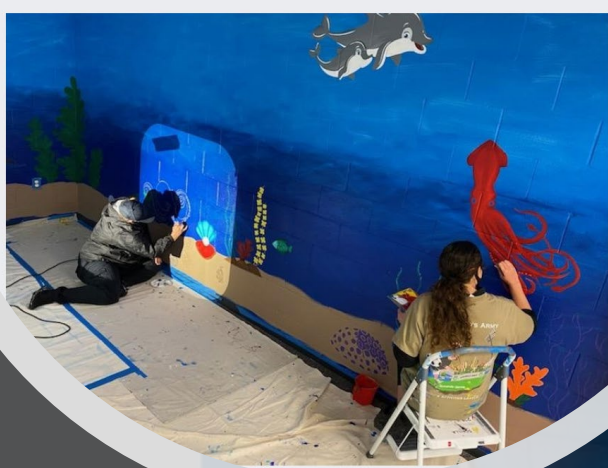
