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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING: A) THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO TO ACCEPT THE ARPA-CBCAP SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT FUND WHICH WILL FURTHER SUPPORT PREVENTION PLANNING EFFORTS AND DIRECT SERVICE ACTIVITIES, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$300,368.00, FROM THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY, B) THE DIRECTOR OF THE HUMAN SERVICES AGENCY (HSA), OR HIS DESIGNEE, TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO IN CONNECTION WITH THE ARPA-CBCAP ALLOCATION AWARD, AND TO ENTER INTO, EXECUTE, AND DELIVER ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED OR DEEMED NECESSARY OR APPROPRIATE FOR ALLOWABLE PREVENTION ACTIVITIES AND TITLE IV-E REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AND C) THE DIRECTOR OF HSA, SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS THAT ARE SPECIFIED IN THE LETTER OF INTENT FOR THE RECEIPT OF AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 (ARPA) COMMUNITY-BASED CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION (CBCAP) SUPPLEMENTAL GRANT ATTACHMENTS A AND B, DATED JANUARY 13, 2021, TO ALLOCATE RECEIVED FUNDS IN THE CONTRACTING OF RELATED SERVICES

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the purpose of Community-Based Child Abuse Prevention (CBCAP) programs are to support community-based efforts to develop, operate, expand, enhance, and coordinate initiatives, programs, and activities to prevent child abuse and neglect, as well as to better strengthen and support families to reduce the likelihood of child abuse and neglect; and

WHEREAS, Counties with a Title IV-E agreement with the State electing to receive funds agree to all reporting requirements set forth by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) and the Administration for Children and Families; and

WHEREAS, the Human Services Agency (HSA) recommends authorizing the Director of HSA, or Director's designee, to apply for and accept funds on behalf of the County of San Mateo for the ARPA-CBCAP allocation; and

WHEREAS, The ARPA-CBCAP allocation will allow for primary and secondary direct service activities which are not limited to the issuance of stipends to those with lived experience to participate in the planning and implementation processes or prevention systems; provide peer to peer support; or other direct services to support families at-risk of entry into the child welfare system.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the President of this Board of Supervisors be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of the County of San Mateo, and the Clerk of the board shall attest the President's signature thereto.

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
