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RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF ELECTIONS OFFICER TO RENDER SPECIFIED ELECTION SERVICES FOR THE PORTOLA VALLEY SCHOOL DISTRICT IN CONJUNCTION WITH A SPECIAL MAIL BALLOT ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, MAY 4, 2021

RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, that

WHEREAS, the governing board of the Portola Valley School District (District) adopted Resolution No. 02-2021, giving notice of a Special Mail Ballot Election to be held on May 4, 2021, for the purpose of submitting a parcel tax measure to District voters, and requesting that this Board of Supervisors authorize the County's Chief Elections Officer to render specified election services to the District therefor; and

WHEREAS, the County's Chief Elections Officer is agreeable to providing specified election services as duly requested and enumerated above in conjunction with the Special Mail Ballot Election to be held on Tuesday, May 4, 2021; and

WHEREAS, absent other arrangements or applicable law, the costs of any school district election shall be borne by the school district holding the election pursuant to Section 5421 of the Education Code; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the services and supplies to be provided by the Chief Elections Officer in conducting said election, the District will, as required by law, enter into an agreement with the County's Chief Elections Officer to outline the services to be rendered and to reimburse the County for the costs of said services and supplies.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Chief Elections Officer is authorized to render specified election services for the May 4, 2021 Special Mail Ballot Election in the District, including entering into a service agreement with the District for those services, the costs for which will be reimbursed by the District as required by law.

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
